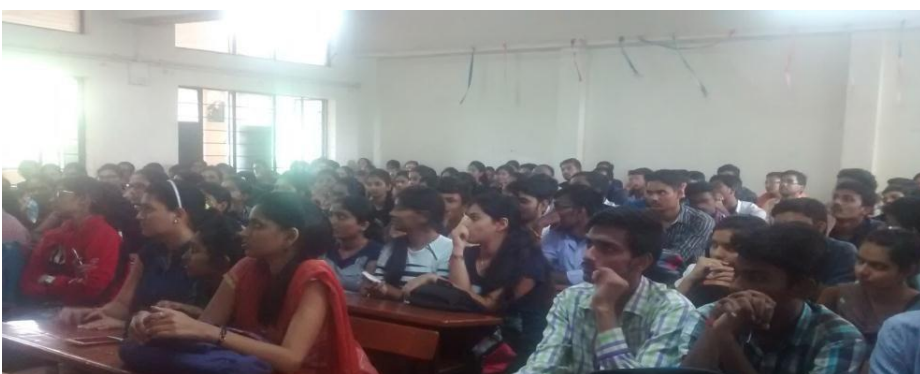

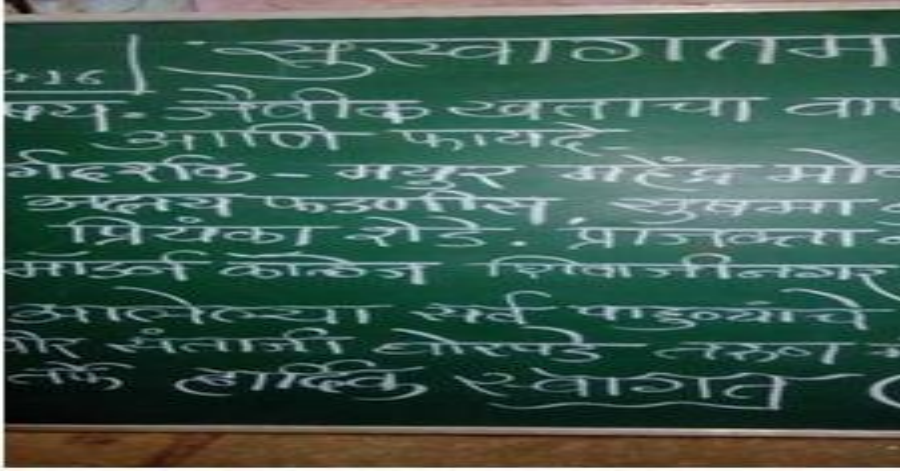
Provide basic needs, education and hygiene to orphans
